Constitution & Bill of Rights

Preamble

H / A "We the **People** of the United States, in order to form a more perfect Union... and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity..."

Article I. Section 2

H / A "No **Person** shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, and been seven Years a **Citizen** of the United States..."

Article I. Section 3

H / A "No **Person** shall be a Senator who shall not have attained to the Age of thirty Years, and been nine Years a Citizen..."

Article II. Section 1

H / A "No **Person** except a natural born **Citizen**... shall be eligible for the Office of President..."

Article III. Section 3

H / A "No **Person** shall be convicted of Treason unless on the Testimony of two **Witnesses**..."

Amendment I

H / A "Congress shall make no law... abridging...the right of the **people** peaceably to assemble..."

Amendment II

H / A "... the right of the **people** to keep and bear Arms shall not be infringed."

Amendment IV

H / A "The right of the **people** to be secure in their **persons**, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures shall not be violated..."

Preamble

H / A "No **Person** shall be convicted of Treason unless on the Testimony of two **Witnesses**..."

Amendment I

H / A "Congress shall make no law... abridging...the right of the **people** peaceably to assemble..."

Amendment II

H / A "... the right of the **people** to keep and bear Arms shall not be infringed."

Amendment IV

H / A "The right of the **people** to be secure in their **persons**, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures shall not be violated..."
